The forticlient doesn't appear to launch at windows startup. It was an easy setup. Followed the instructions they provided after install and it worked the first time. They advertise it only does SSL-VPN right now, so it doesn't deserve low stars because it doesn't have all the features of the desktop client. For what is advertised as it does its job. Many complain that it doesn't work with self-signed certificates. It does. Read the instructions. You have to add "ikev1" to the end of your server name. Works Perfectly so far. Thank!

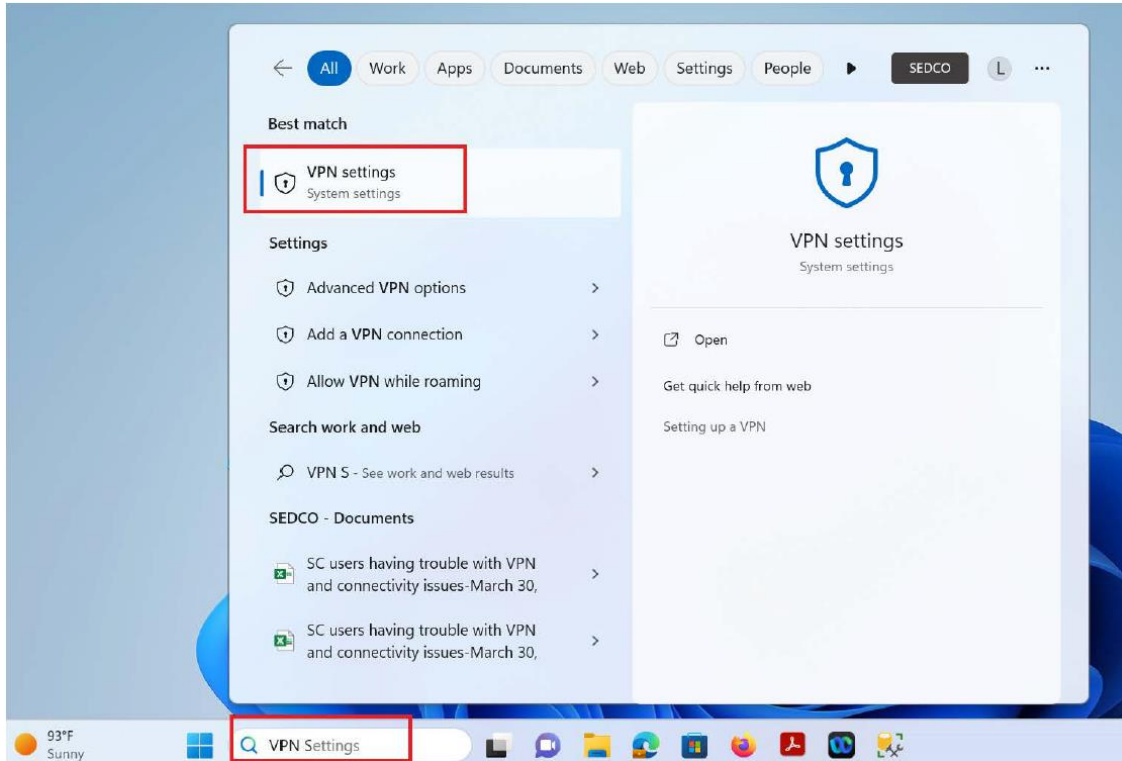
